#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

For consideration for SCAD study abroad programs, students must be in good standing with the university. Class standing, GPA and seat availability in courses are also factors for acceptance. Current students have priority; however, non- SCAD students may apply. In addition to submitting a completed application, students must have their course selections approved by their student success adviser or graduate adviser via an advising confirmation form; students will be prompted by the application system to upload this form. Students interested in applying should schedule an appointment with their adviser prior to completing the online application. Non-majors are welcome to apply.
